ELIGIBILITY: Only dogs with an AKC TD or TDU title may apply for entry in this test.

ENTRY FEE: \$150.00 per VST entry.

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 PM Wednesday, August 1, 2018, at the Test Secretary's home after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted. The test secretary will notify entrants as soon as practicable, via email, that their entry has been received. Entrants should contact the test secretary if they have sent an entry and not received confirmation of its arrival.

THE TEST WORKER OPTION will be offered with 2 tracks set aside for those who have worked at club tracking tests held in the past two years.

A RANDOM DRAWING for entries will be held on Wednesday, August 1, 2018, at 7:00 PM at the Test Secretary's home. This test is open to all AKC-Recognized Breeds and All American Dogs. The drawing for VST entries will be conducted as follows, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17b (Specialty Club Option) of the AKC Tracking Regulations amended to May 9, 2017:

After the entry limit is reached, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will attempt to notify all entries of the results of the draw by mail or e-mail within 48 hours. Entrants may call the Test Secretary until 9:00 PM on August 1 concerning the results of the draw.

ALTERNATES: If an alternate track is plotted and laid, it will be at the judges' discretion to determine whether or not it will be available as a titling track.

WITHDRAWALS: If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date, and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. The entry fee for an alternate who does not participate will be refunded within seven days after the test. Withdrawals must be in writing or by e-mail to the Test Secretary.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS, UNH Dairy Bar/Train Station

FROM THE NORTH & SOUTH: From I-95 take exit 4, Spaulding Turnpike, Routes 4 West and 16 North (left exit from the south). Just before the Dover tolls, take exit # 6W, Rte. 4 West towards Durham and Concord. In Durham, take exit Route 155A UNH, and turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto 155A east. * Go 1.1 mile on 155A east, straight through the traffic rotary, passing tennis courts on your right. Just over the railroad tracks, turn sharply left onto Depot Rd, adjacent to the large artificial turf athletic field. Proceed 50 yards to Dairy Bar. Observe all speed limits in Durham!

FROM THE MANCHESTER NH AREA: Take NH-101 East to exit 7, Route 125. Follow NH-125 North to the traffic rotary and take the first exit onto US-4 East. Take the Rte. 155A UNH exit onto 155A east and continue from * above.

FROM NW NH AND VT: Take I-89 South, to I-93 North exit 15, to I-393 East to US Route 4 East. Take the Route 155A UNH exit onto 155A East and continue from * above.
