Just before the toll booths, take Exit 6W on the right, Route 4 West towards Durham and Concord. Follow Route 4 almost seven miles to the exit for Route 155A UNH, Durham. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto 155A East and travel just over a mile, passing horse barns and greenhouses on your left and tennis courts on your right. As required by the AKC Tracking Regulations, a written certification must accompany the TD or TDU entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test.

All entrants submitting certifications should enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope so that unused certifications may be returned.

In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the Tracking Regulations, the Test Secretary may enter and handle a dog that she owns or co-owns.

SUBSTITUTION OF TRACKS: In the event that there are insufficient TD, TDU, TDX or VST entries, tracks may be substituted using the factor of 2 TDs = 2 TDUs = 1 TDX = 1 VST as specified in Chapter 1, Section 15 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

The drawings for entries and alternates will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. These TD/TDU/TDX/VST Tests are open to all breeds, with preference given to Golden Retrievers.

The drawing will take place at Susan Palius' home at 8:00 AM on Thursday, April 17, 2025 or as soon as practicable thereafter. After the entry limit is reached in TD, TDU, TDX or VST, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entries of the results of the draw by e-mail as soon as practicable after the draw.

WITHDRAWALS: Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary. If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date and is replaced by an alternate, the entry check will not be used, however, if the entrant is not replaced by an alternate the check will be used. The entry check for an alternate that does not participate will not be used.
